Name variations in records include: Barrey, Barry, Berrey, Berry, Berrye.

First Generation

1.Wililam² **BERRY** was born in 1619^[2] and died before 1654^[14]. Parsons & Savage say that William was in Portsmouth, Rockingham co., NH as early as 1631, as one of those sent to settle the area by John Mason. However, more proof of this is necessary, as William Berry is neither listed in Coldham^[16], nor Anderson^[17].

In 1635, he moved to Newbury, Essex co., MA and was made Freeman there on 18 May 1642^[15]. By 1648 or so, he had moved back to the Portsmouth, Rockingham co., NH area; when it was "...Granted that Wm Berry shall have a lot upon the neck of land upon the South side of the Little River at Sandy Beach..." at a Strawbery Banke town meeting in 1648 or 1649^[14]. This land grant and residence at the time of his death was in Sandy Beach (now Rye), Rockingham co., NH^[43] and was squabbled over by his descendants for 60 years^[43]. I have identified James Berry and Joshua Foss and noted their part in this resolution in their own entries below. I cannot ascertain the parentage of John Berry as being the son of William and so have refrained from mentioning participation in his entry. The official resolution of this reads as follows:

"Wee James Berry son of William Berry of sandy Beach: Deceased: & John Berry & Joshua ffoss Grand children of the said Wm Berry Deceasd have Mutually agreed on the Divission of the Neck of Land Granted the said Wm Berry: about Sixty years since, and in our possessn Ever Since sd Wm Berry Deceas'd: & for our Quiet and that Each Brother & Brothes child may Know his own proper part, have agreed on the six Divisions as above Made, and in testimony of our agreement have hereunto set our hands this thirteenth Day of June in the yeare of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen

before 1636/7, he married **Jane [surname not known]**, in Portsmouth, Rockingham co., NH or Newbury, Essex co., MA^[1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13]. Before 1657 when Jane was 38, she second married **Nathaniel DRAKE**^[2,14].

- **4. Joseph BERRY** (*William*¹) was born circa 1639 and died before 1717; he was 78. Joseph was of Portsmouth, Rockingham co., NH. Circa 1671/1683 when Joseph was 32, he married **Rachel [GUTCH?]**^[2], in Kittery, York co., ME^[2,24,25,22,26].
- **5. Mary**² **BERRY.** (William¹) Upon arrival in Rye, John was supposedly taken in by the family of John Berry and married his daughter, Mary^[6]. However, with further research, we now know that Mary and John were siblings (although it is possible that Mary was living in her brother's house) and both were children of William & Jane Berry. This is unmistakably proven by the fact that John & Mary Foss witnessed her sister Rachel Berry Marsden's will on 12 February 1706/7. Stackpole's assertion that she is the daughter of William Chadbourne of Kittery, York co., ME is based upon her mention in Humphrey Chadbourne's will. However, I believe that he confused the fact that her second husband was William's son William Chadbourne and thus she was mentioned in her bother-in-law Humphrey's will.

Circa 1660 Mary first married **John FOSS**, in Rye Beach, Rockingham co., New Hampshire^[2,27,28,29].

Jane second married **Robert COATES**, a Cordwainer^[49]. Robert died before 1 September 1724 in New Castle, Rockingham co., NH^[48].

This is Robert Coates of Lynn, Essex co., MA (1714-1724) who bought land in New Castle, Rockingham co., NH in 1723. He is specifically mentioned in the New Castle town records as being from Lynn. This (along with Sarah Coates) is a link with my mother's Coates' side of the family. Finding how Robert fits into the family tree has been...difficult. By all current accounts, this Robert (in fact nearly all Robert Coates) should have been in Stonington, CT and NOT New Castle, NH. However, his marriage record and administration of estate indicate otherwise.

A branch of the Thomas Coates line of the family (Thomas' son Thomas) removed from Lynn, Essex co., MA to Newbury, Essex co., MA ca. 1695. Later, it is postulated that they removed further to Portsmouth, Rockingham co., NH by 1700-1709 (when Thomas and his son were fined there for selling without a license). This Thomas' mother and father suffered persecution while at Lynn for their Quaker Faith, so a move to more tolerant climes might have been a relief^[50]. Research to sort this out is ongoing.

Administration on the estate of Robert Coates of New Castle was granted to his widow Jane Coates on 1 September 1724. [Probate Record, vol. 10, p. 331^[48]

Details of the administration of his estate are as follows: "...Bond, in blank, September 2, 1724, signed by Jane Coates, Richard Neal, and John Vennnard...Inventory, September 1724, amount £85.15.0; signed by Sampson Sheafe, Jr. and Benjamin Parker...License September 11, 1725 to the administratrix to sell real estate...Guardianship of John Coats, minor, more than 14 years old, son of Robert Coates, cordwainer, granted to David Mitchell of New Castle, fisherman, November 16, 1737..." [48]
