Surname variations include Brown and Browne.

1. **Edward¹ BROWN** married **Jane LIDE**, sometime before 1615, most likely in Inkeberrow, Worcestershire, England. Her surname is various spelled Lide, Lieds and Leeds. Assuming that Ann is the first child of a first marriage for both of them, Edward and Jane were probably born circa 1595/1600.

2. **Ann² BROWN** (*Edward¹*) was born circa 1615 in Inkeberrow, Worcestershire, England^[1] and died in Lynn, Essex co., MA on 4d:10m(December):1669; she was 54, as "Haukes, An, w. Adam"^[2,3].

Ann first married **[not known] HUTCHINSON^[2,4]**, who died before 1631^[2], when Ann is believed to have remarried. Circa 1631 when Ann was 16, she second married **Adam HAWKES**, son of **John HAWKES & [not known]**, in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA or -- more likely -- Lynn, Essex co., MA^[2,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19].
