Name variations found in the records include: Chadwell, Chadwill, & Chatwell. Chadwel is also found, but mostly in the 1700s and primarily for Harris Chadwell's family.

**2. Thomas**<sup>2</sup> **CHADWELL Sr.** (*Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1611/1612 in Little Barrington, Cotswold Region, Gloucestershire, England<sup>[1,2]</sup>. Another source says Tintros, England, but Little Barrington seems more likely. Thomas died in Lynn, Essex co., MA in "last of" February 1683; he was 72<sup>[1,3]</sup>. On his death record, he is listed as "Thomas, Sr." -- perhaps this is to differentiate him from his grandson Thomas, since he did not have a son with that name. He and his brother, Richard were Shipwrights.

Thomas was in Salem, Essex co., MA by 2 March 1637, when he was received as an inhabitant of Salem and was granted 10 acres on the Cape Ann side<sup>[2]</sup>. He moved to Lynn, Essex co., MA by 10 April 1637, when Moses was born, and lived on Summer Street. In the 1638 Lynn Land Distribution, he was granted 60 acres. Thomas and his third wife, Abigail, moved to Charlestown, Middlesex co., MA after their marriage where Thomas was admitted to the church at Charlestown on 3 April 1670<sup>[4]</sup>. After his death, his estate was valued at £137 5s. 0d<sup>[2]</sup>.

Before 1637 when Thomas was 26, he first married **Margaret [surname not known]**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1,5,6,7,8,9]</sup>. Margaret died on 29d:7m(September):1658 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1,10]</sup>.

After 1658 when Thomas was 47, he second married **Barbara [surname not known]**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA or Boston, Suffolk co., MA<sup>[1,9,6,11,12,7,13]</sup>. Barbara died before 1665<sup>[1]</sup>.

Before 1679 when Thomas was 68, he third married **Abigail WYETH**, in Charlestown, Middlesex co., MA<sup>[1,9,14,11,15,16]</sup>. Abigail died on 4d:9m(November):1683 in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA<sup>[1,4]</sup>.

**3. Richard CHADWELL.** (*Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) Not much is known of him save the following mention in Wyman's Genealogies & Estates of Charlestown: In 1655, Richard "...Promises to pay John Trumbull at Barbados...(per court files)"<sup>[4]</sup>

On 22 July 1649 Richard married **Katherine PRESBURY or PRESBERRY**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1]</sup>. Richard adopted her only daughter Margaret. They had no other children.

**4. Moses**<sup>3</sup> **CHADWELL**<sup>[17]</sup> (*Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 10d:2m(April):1637 in Lynn, Essex co.,  $MA^{[1,18,2,19]}$  and died in at sea on 25 April 1684; he was  $46^{[1,18]}$ . Moses was a Shipwright<sup>[20]</sup>.

On 12m (Feb): 1660/1 when Moses was 22, he married **Sarah IVORY**, daughter of **William IVORY** & **Ann SOUTH**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1,21,22,23,24,25,26,27]</sup>

- **5. Ruth CHADWELL** (*Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1640 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1]</sup>. On 24d:12m(February):1658 when Ruth was 18, she married **Daniel NEEDHAM**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[29]</sup>.
- **6. Benjamin CHADWELL** (*Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1642 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[2]</sup>. Benjamin died in at sea in April 1679; he was 37<sup>[30]</sup>. Benjamin was a Ship's carpenter<sup>[2]</sup> and his descendants became the Ipswich branch of the family<sup>[31]</sup>. Inventory of his estate is in Essex Probate, 1679<sup>[30]</sup>.

On 20 December 1666 when Benjamin was 24, he married **Elizabeth HAWES**, daughter of **Joseph HAWES** & **Elizabeth NEEDHAM**, in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA<sup>[2,4]</sup>.

Thomas CHADWELL** (Moses³, Thomas², Not Known¹) was born on 11d:10m(December):1662 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[2,18,32]</sup> and died in Lynn, Essex co., MA on 16 January 1740; he was 77<sup>[2]</sup>. Thomas was a husbandman & fisherman<sup>[2]</sup>. On 7 Jan 1740/1, Thomas gave his grandson Moses Newhall real estate in Lynn. Moses' brother Jacob Newhall, Jr. witnessed the deed<sup>[33]</sup>. He was active in Lynn town affairs<sup>[2]</sup>.

Circa 1686 when Thomas was 23, he first married **Hannah SMITH**, daughter of **Richard SMITH** & **Hannah CHENEY**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[2]</sup>.

They had one child:

Thomas second married **Sarah NEWHALL**, widow of **Thomas BREED**, daughter of **John NEWHALL Jr.** & **Elizabeth NORMANTON**. Sarah was born on 22 August 1662<sup>[34,35]</sup> and was buried on 27 November 1688<sup>[36]</sup>. She is Waters #68.

- **9. Sarah CHADWELL** (Moses<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Not Known<sup>1</sup>) was born on 12 March 1667/8 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[2,32]</sup>.
- **10. [possibly Lois?] CHADWELL** (*Moses*<sup>3</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 3 October 1670<sup>[2]</sup>. Lois died on 28 February 1737; she was 66<sup>[44]</sup>. All of Moses & Sarah's children's births were meticulously recorded in the Lynn vital records, but her birth record is not anywhere in the Essex county records. There is no listed marriage record of a male Chadwell to a woman named Lois. The only mention of her is in Marcia Wiswall's article in *The Essex Genealogist*<sup>[2]</sup>. Wiswall states her birth & death records and is listed by her as being unmarried. Yet, the death record in Lynn reads "Chadwell, Lois, Mrs. Feb. 28, 1737-8, a. 65 y." I don't think she is a child of Moses and Sarah. I need more conclusive proof that she is.
- **11. Moses CHADWELL** (Moses<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Not Known<sup>1</sup>) was born on 11 September 1673 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[37]</sup> and died in Lynn, Essex co., MA on 29 September 1676; he was 3<sup>[45]</sup>.
- **12. Margaret CHADWELL** (Moses<sup>3</sup>, Thomas<sup>2</sup>, Not Known<sup>1</sup>) was born on 30 September 1676 and died in Lynn, Essex co., MA on 29 November 1693; she was 17<sup>[45]</sup>.
- **13. Anna CHADWELL** (*Moses*<sup>3</sup>, *Thomas*<sup>2</sup>, *Not Known*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 17 June 1679 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[46]</sup>. On 27 November 1697 when Anna was 18, she married **Jonathon RAMSDELL**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[47]</sup>.
- **14.** Elizabeth CHADWELL (Moses³, Thomas², Not Known¹) was born on 18 December 1681 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[46]</sup>. On 31 October 1710 when Elizabeth was 28, she first married **John RAMSDELL**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[2,47]</sup>. On 16 May 1728 when Elizabeth was 46, she second married **Joseph BATES**<sup>[2]</sup>.
