2. **Mary<sup>2</sup> COOPER** (*Timothy<sup>1</sup>*) was born circa 1606, perhaps in Appley, England and died in Lynn, Essex co., MA in 6m(August):1653 as "Burel, Mary, w. George."; she was 47<sup>[1]</sup>.

On 12 January 1626/7 when Mary was 20, she married **George BURRILL**, son of **George BURRILL & Alyce BENYSON**, in Boston, Lincolnshire, England<sup>[2,3,4,5,6,7,8]</sup>.
