Surname variations include Echyyngham, Echyngham, Echngham and Etchingham.

#### **First Generation**

**1**. **Sir William<sup>1</sup> ECHYNGHAM** died on 20 Mar 1412/13<sup>[2,3]</sup>. William was of Echyngham [or Etchingham], Sussex, England<sup>[6]</sup>, although another Weis source says that Echyngham was in Suffolk, England<sup>[2]</sup>, Suffolk is incorrect.

Circa 1401, William married<sup>[2,3,5]</sup> Joan FITZ ALAN<sup>[1,2,3,4]</sup> of Arundel, England<sup>[3]</sup>. Joan was the daughter of Sir John FITZ ALAN, the first Baron of Arundel, and Eleanor MALTRAVERS and the widow of Sir William DE BRIEN. Joan died on 1 September 1404<sup>[2,3]</sup>.

2. Jane<sup>2</sup> ECHYNGHAM<sup>[1]</sup> (*William<sup>1</sup>*) was of Echyngham, Sussex, England and married [not known] BAYTUN.

**3.** Sir & Lord Thomas ECHYYNGHAM<sup>[7]</sup> (*William*<sup>1</sup>) was born circa 1401<sup>[8]</sup> and died on 15 October 1444; he was 43<sup>[8,9]</sup>. He was his father's heir and thus was Lord of Echyngham, Sussex, England<sup>[8]</sup>.

His descendants can be traced through Weis' <u>The Magna Charta Sureties</u>, lines 88-10+ & 88A-10+ and Weis' <u>Ancestral Roots</u>, line 59-36+

Thomas' will was dated 20 August 1444 and proved at Lambeth on 28 October 1444<sup>[10]</sup>.

Thomas first married Agnes DE SHOYSWELL, daughter of John DE SHOYSWELL.

In 1415-1424 when Thomas was 14, he second married **Margaret KNYVET**, daughter of **Sir Thomas KNYVET** & **Joan OF NORFOLK**<sup>[8]</sup>. Margaret died after 1467, when she was noted as "still living"<sup>[8]</sup>.
