2. Hannah FROST (*Henry*¹) was born circa 1617, as estimated from her death information^[3], and died in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA on 2 February 1698/9; she was 81^[4,5]. She is variously referred to as Hannah, Joanna and Hanna. She migrated with her husband Richard and her family from England by 1648. At that time, Richard was admitted as an official resident of Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA^[6]. "Johanna" was admitted to the church at Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA on 14d:1m(March):1652^[6].

Before 15 October 1647 when Hannah was 30, she married **Richard STOWERS**, son of **Nicholas STOWERS & Amy [surname not known]**, in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA^[4,7,8,9,10]. An intention was also filed. Richard was born circa 1617 in England^[4,11].
