1. Doctor John¹ GIFFORD was born in 1625^[1] and died in 1693; he was 68^[1]. In addition to owning a farm in the Saugus area, John was the infamous agent for the Iron Works in Saugus during the protracted legal actions between the Iron Works & the Hawkes family during the late 1600s, which culminated with John Hawkes cutting the dam^[2]. Thus, it is ironic that his granddaughter, Margaret Cogswell, married John Hawkes' son, Moses.

Circa 1651 when John was 26, he married Margaret TEMPLE, in Lynn, Essex co., MA^[1,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12].
