1. Michael¹ MIDDLEBROOK. This is possibly the Michael Middlebrook who died in 1616 in Batley, Yorkshire, England and was buried there on 31 December 1616^[1]. Michael definitely lived in Batley, Yorkshire, England^[1]. One 1920 source says he lived in "Hold Mills", Yorkshire, England. The location -- then or now -- of this village has never been established^[2].

Michael married **Grace [surname not known]** who died in 1656 in Batley, Yorkshire, England and was buried there on 5 December 1656^[1].

3. Esther/Hester MIDDLEBROOK (*Michael*¹) died after 10 September 1655 in New Haven, CT^[3]. Torrey wasn't sure if she was "Esther RAYNER" or "Hester MIDDLEBROOK"^[4] and this question remained until just recently. This issue was definitively solved in Maxine Stansell's article in the October 2002 issue of *NEHGR* entitled "The Middlebrook Sisters: Mother and Mother-In-Law of Michael Wigglesworth^[5]".

On 27 October 1629 Esther/Hester married **Edward WIGGLESWORTH**, son of **William WIGGLESWORTH**, in Wrawby, Lincolnshire, England^[4,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14]. Torrey simply states that they were married "before 1631". The aforementioned *NEHGR* article cites the Bishops' Transcripts of Wrawby, Lincolnshire, England, which list a record for: "[] Wiglesworth" to "Ester Middlebrooke". She migrated with her husband and son to New England in 1638. They first settled in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA; then removed to New Haven, CT.

4. Matthew MIDDLEBROOK (*Michael*¹) died after 6 April 1657 in Batley, Yorkshire, England^[19]. On 24 May 1637 Matthew married **Mary COOKSON**, daughter of **Christopher COOKSON**, in Batley, Yorkshire, England^[19].

5. Grace MIDDLEBROOK (*Michael*¹) was born in 1609 in Batley, Yorkshire, England and was baptized there on 11 April 1609^[19]. She married **Christopher TODD**. They came to New England and settled in New Haven [CT] Colony by 1638^[14].

6. Michael MIDDLEBROOK (*Michael*¹) married a woman about whom we currently know nothing.

7. Mercy MIDDLEBROOK (*Michael*¹) was born in 1616 in Batley, Yorkshire, England and was baptized there on 21 December 1616^[19]. Mercy died in 1616/7 in Batley, Yorkshire, England and was buried there on 5 January 1616/7^[19].
