

# Rand Register Report

## First Generation

---

**1. Robert<sup>1</sup> RAND, Sr.** died on 8 November 1694 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1]</sup>. He does not appear to be descended from Robert Rand of Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA<sup>[4]</sup>. Pity, that... Name variations include: Ran, Rand & Rande.

Robert, along with John Newhall, took inventory on the estate of Samuel Mansfield of Lynn on 24d:4m:1679<sup>[6]</sup>. On June 24, 1681, he and William Bassett took inventory of the estate of Richard Richeson of Lynn<sup>[7]</sup>. From these two inventories, we have a good idea of his education level, since he could only "make his mark" on them<sup>[2]</sup>. Since he would have been in the prime of his life and not debilitated by infirmity (as many people were when they made their wills), it is a good guess that he was illiterate.

In the accounting of John Humphries, Esq.'s estate, £30 was owed to "Robt. Rane for buildinge of Barne and abatement of Rent" also Cr. what has been received from Robt. Rane for 4 years Rent" £40. "Jo. Rand" owes 24s. 8d. to Abraham Toppan of Newbury's estate<sup>[3]</sup>. Also mentioned was "£61 6s. 10d. to "Rich. Hude [Hood] for Repairing of dwellinge house" and "what has been received from Richard Hude for three years Rent" £31<sup>[5]</sup>.

Before 1653 Robert married **Elizabeth [surname not known]**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[8,9]</sup>. She died on 29 August 1693 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[1]</sup>.

**2. Mary<sup>2</sup> RAND.** (*Robert<sup>1</sup>*) On 20 June 1675 Mary first married **Nathaniel KERTLAND Jr.**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21]</sup>, who died in 1690<sup>[11]</sup>. Name variations include: Kirtland, Kartland, Keartland, Kertland & Kyrtland.

On 24 April 1690 Mary second married **Dr. John Henry BURCHSTED**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[11,14,15,20,21,22,23,24,25,26]</sup> Their marriage record reads "Busted, John Hennery, and wid. Mary [Rand, P.R.17] Kertland.

**3. Robert RAND Jr.** (*Robert*<sup>1</sup>) died on 6 December 1717 in Lynn, Essex co., MA "In his 64th year"<sup>[1]</sup>. Sometime in the "last of" January 1683 Robert married **Tabitha IVORY**, daughter of **William IVORY & Ann SOUTH**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[10]</sup>. Tabitha died on 24d:8m:1743 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[30]</sup>. Her Lynn, Essex co., MA death record is most likely "Rand, \_\_, wid., "old", but this is speculation on my part.

**4. Hannah RAND** (*Robert*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 6m(August):1657 in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[31]</sup>. On 18 September 1682 when Hannah was 25, she married **Jacob KNIGHT**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[10]</sup>.

**5. Elizabeth RAND.** (*Robert*<sup>1</sup>) On 3 March 1673/4 Elizabeth married **Joseph HALL**, son of **Edward HALL** and **Sarah [surname not known]**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[32]</sup>.

**6. Sarah RAND.** (*Robert*<sup>1</sup>) On 1 July 1674 Sarah married **Ephriam HALL**, son of **Edward HALL** and **Sarah [surname not known]**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[10]</sup>.

**7. Zachariah RAND** (*Robert*<sup>1</sup>) died on 6 April 1765 in Lynn, Essex co., MA aged 76 y<sup>[1]</sup>. On 2 April 1684 Zachariah married **Anna IVORY**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[10]</sup>.
