1. Francis¹ SMITH was born somewhere in England and died on 20 March 1649/50 in Reading, Middlesex co., MA^[1,2,3]. His migration information is currently unknown, however he was one of the earliest migrants to Massachusetts and one of the early settlers of several towns in the Boston, Suffolk co., MA area. We know from town records that he was in Watertown, Middlesex co., MA by early 1628.

He first settled in Watertown, Middlesex co., MA, receiving an eight acre grant (as townsman #34) in the following land grant of 28 February 1628: "A Granto of the Plowlands at Beverbroke Planes, Devided & Lotted out by the Freeman to all the Townesmen then Inhabiting being 106 in number. Allowing one Acre for a person & likewise for cattle valued at £20 ye head, beginning next to the small Lotts beyond the ware..." ^[5].

In 1637, Francis was made a Freeman of Watertown^[2]. On 26 June 1637 in Watertown: "A Grant of the Remote or Westpine Meaddows, devided & Lotted out by the Freemen to all the Townesmen then Inhabiting being 113 in number; allowing one Acre for a person, & likewise for cattle valued at £20 the Head beginning next to Plaine Meaddow & so to go on vntill the Lotts be ended..." Francis Smith is number 102 and was granted another eight acres^[6].

In 1636-1637 and 1642, Francis was called a Proprietor in Watertown^[1,4]. On 10d:3m:1642, he received another Watertown land grant: "Ordered that all the Townes Men that hath nor Farmes laid out formerly shall take them by Ten in a Division & cast Lotts for the severall Divisions allowing 13 Acres of vpland to every head of Persons & cattle." Francis is part of Lott 9 Division & received a grant of lot #94, which had 131 acres^[1,7].

In the 1644 inventory of Lands & Posessions in Watertown, Francis' holdings were:

1. A homestall of Six Acres, the marsh to the south, John Smith to the north, Henry Cuttris on the East and Jeremiah Norcrosse to the West.

- 2. 2 acres of Marsh
- 3. 3 acres of upland
- 4. Eight acres of plowland in the "hither Plaine"
- 5. Eight acres of remote Meddow & the hundred & second lott granted to him.
- 6. Thirty acres of upland received in the second Division & twenty-one lot granted to him.
- 7. Thirteen acres & half of upland^[8].

In 1647, Francis moved his family to Reading, Middlesex co., MA and was one of the first settlers of the town. He settled at the north end of Smith's Pond (which is named for him), with his land extending around the pond and into what is now Woodville. He served as a Selectman in Reading^[2]. The location of his house is near where the Wakefield Junction Railroad Station stood^[2]. He also lived for a while in Rumney Marsh (later Chelsea Ferry, now Chelsea), Suffolk co., MA.

Francis' will is dated 14 March 1650/1^[1]. In it, he mentions wife, though not by name, and sons John, Benjamin and granddaughter Mary Smith. He also left "To my kinsmen Henry and Benjamin Bulflower of the town, each £3. For fencing the burial lot, $£3^{"[1]}$.

Before 1621 Francis married **Alice [surname not known]**, in Watertown or Reading, Middlesex co., MA^[910,11,12]. Alice was born in 1583 (as estimated from her age given on her death record) and died in 1667; she was 84^[9]. She was buried on 13d:3m:1667 in Roxbury, Suffolk co., MA "a. abt. 84 y."^[13]

2. Lieutenant & Captain John² SMITH (*Francis¹*) was born in 1621 in Watertown, Middlesex co., MA^[2,9]. This birth year is estimated from his given age on his death record. John died in Chelsea, Suffolk co., MA on 21 September 1706; he was 85^[9,14]. John is buried in North Chelsea (now Revere), Suffolk co., MA.

John lived at Winnesimmet (now Chelsea), Suffolk co., MA^[14]. He bought land in Charlestown, Suffolk co., MA from R. Kennicut in 1678 and sold 12.5 acres from the second division to John Wilson, Sr. at some point. The deed was witnessed by Thomas Goodwell and William Johnson and was acknowledged in 1682 (although that is not the date of sale).

John served in the local militia and was a Lieutenant until at least 1663 (date of 2nd marriage), but a Captain by the time of his wife's death in 1694.

On 1 August 1647 when John was 26, he first married **Catherine MORRILL**, daughter of **Isaac MORRILL**, in Reading, Middlesex co., MA^[2,9,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21]. Their marriage was also in the Roxbury, Suffolk co., MA vital records as "Smith, John & Katherine Morrol". Catherine was born circa 1635 and died in Reading, Middlesex co., MA on 12 September 1662; she was 27^[2,3,9,14]. Her death record reads "Smith, Katherine". She is buried with John in North Chelsea, MA (now Revere), Suffolk co., MA.

On 6 January 1662/3 when John was 41, he second married **Mary BILL**, daughter of **James BILL**, **Sr. & Mary [surname not known]** in Reading, Middlesex co., MA or Boston, Suffolk co., MA^[2,9,15,16,22,23,24,25]. Mary was born circa 1645 and died in Chelsea, MA on 6 February 1693/4; she was $48^{[14]}$. She is also buried in North Chelsea (now Revere), Suffolk co., MA^[4]. Note that on her marriage record, she is called "Martha" and is said to be "from Boston". In family genealogies, this Mary Bill is sometimes confused with her aunt, who is the Mary Bill who was born circa 1624 and came over on the *Planter* in 1635.

Deacon Francis³ SMITH (*John²*, *Francis¹*) was born on 23 December 1658 in Reading, Middlesex co., MA as "Smith, Frances"^[2,9,14,30] and died in Reading, Middlesex co., MA on 14 November 1744 as "Smith, Francis, Dea..in his 86th y."^[3,9,33]. He inherited the homestead around Smith's Pond and lived in Reading, Middlesex co., MA his entire life^[33]. In addition to being a Deacon of the church, Francis served as Selectman & Town Clerk of Reading^[33].

On 1 March 1679/80 when Francis was 20, he married **Ruth MAVERICK**, daughter of **Elias MAVERICK** & **Anna HARRIS**, in Reading, Middlesex co., MA^[9,16, 34,35,36,37,38,39,40].
