**2.** Ann<sup>2</sup> SOUTH (*Thomas*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1602, as estimated from a 1682 deposition, and died before 1689, which was the date of her will's record; she was 87<sup>[1]</sup>. Ann's will was written in 1675 and recorded 9m(November):1689<sup>[2,3]</sup>. Circa 1632 when Ann was 30, she first married **William IVORY**<sup>[4]</sup>, son of **William IVORY**, in Lynn, Essex co., MA<sup>[5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18]</sup>.
