**1. Walter<sup>1</sup> TIBBOT** was born in 1584 in England<sup>[1]</sup> and died in Gloucester, Essex co., MA on 14d:6m(August):1652 as "Tibbit, Walter"; he was 68<sup>[1,13]</sup>. The year of his death should be 1651 because his wife remarried in 2m(May) of 1652.

Walter migrated from Wales to Marshfield, Plymouth co., MA with The Reverend Richard Blinman. He settled in Gloucester, Essex co., MA in 1642, as one of the early "props." and took the Oath of Freeman on 19 May 1642 in Gloucester, Essex co., MA<sup>[20,21,22]</sup>.

Dated ye 5r of ye 4, 1651.*

*"The will of Walter Tibbot of Gloucester, deceased 14d:6m:1651, was delivered into this court by Robert Tucker, but cannot now be found; a copy whereof is now presented, Mr. Wm. Perkins and Robert Tucker, testifying to the truth of it, upon whose testimony the court, Oct. 19, 1652 doth allow the same."<sup>[16,17]</sup>*

On 6 November 1643 Mary married **Captain William HASKELL**, son of **William HASKELL & Elinor/Eilin FOULE**, in Gloucester, Essex co., MA<sup>[1,6,8,9,25,26,27,28,29,30]</sup>. Their marriage record reads: "Hascall, Will[iam], and Marie Tybb[ot, T.C.], d. Wa[l]ter".
