2. Elizabeth² **WHEELER** (*Thomas*¹) was born in 1602 and was baptized in Cranfield, Bedfordshire, England on 18 July 1602. She died in Lynn, Essex co., MA before 28d:1m(March):1656, when her husband remarried; she was 54. Elizabeth and Allen "Broad" are named in her father's will^[2,3].

On 14 November 1622 when Elizabeth was 20, she married **Allen BREED**, son of **John BREED & Agnes PRITCHETT**, in Pullohill, Bedfordshire, England^[4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17]. Torrey identifies the town where they were married as "Pulloxhill".
