(I think) the riffs just repeat throughout the song. You may split them up and use two guitars... and play both on one.. (that's what I do) If anyone wants the words I can give them to you.. mail me. The song is called, and I don't know how to spell it, A'Soalin Cake (something like that:)

That final harmonic is on the 12th fret. I hope you can make sense of this. I don't know how to show the fingering I use. but I pick the top reps with only my index finger (when doing both parts) and use my thumb for the bottom riff. The positions I use with my left hand are all index and middle finger and then thumb on the 3-2-0 bottom E (You'll find that's a stretch to hit 2 and 5 on opposite E's. but it's not that hard at all... and once you play this enough. it's second nature. and basic rythym...

The lyrics are kind of Christmas-like.. so look them up or mail  $\ensuremath{\text{me}}.$
